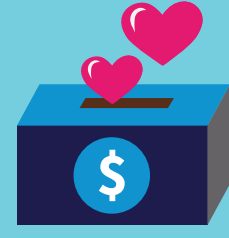

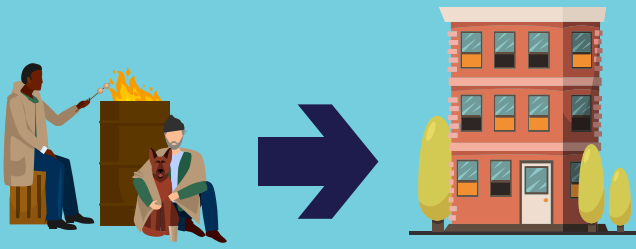

Nicholas House's **Homeless to Homes** and **Home Again** programs are designed to assist families when they have an income, but need temporary help with the costs.

served had the ability to pay their own housing expenses **12 months** after the cessation of housing benefits provided and **100% of families** served had the ability to pay their own housing expenses **24 months** after the cessation of housing benefits provided.

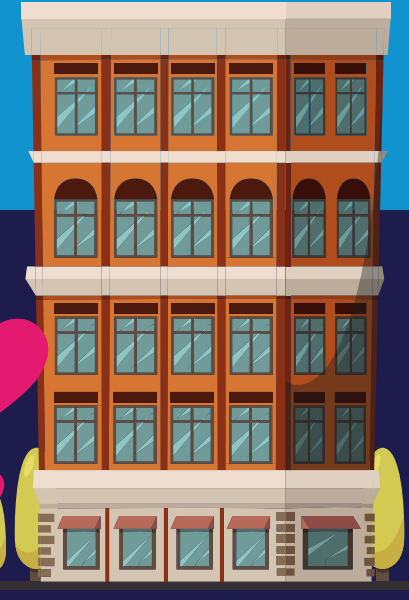
72%

Nicholas House's **New Horizons** program provides permanent affordable housing for as long as a family needs it. This program is reserved for families who have chronic health conditions that would make it difficult for them to maintain stable employment. They need stable housing and support so they don't cycle in and out of homelessness.



NEW HORIZONS SERVED 77 PEOPLE LAST YEAR WITH AN AVERAGE STAY OF 12 MONTHS OR LONGER IN THE PROGRAM.
