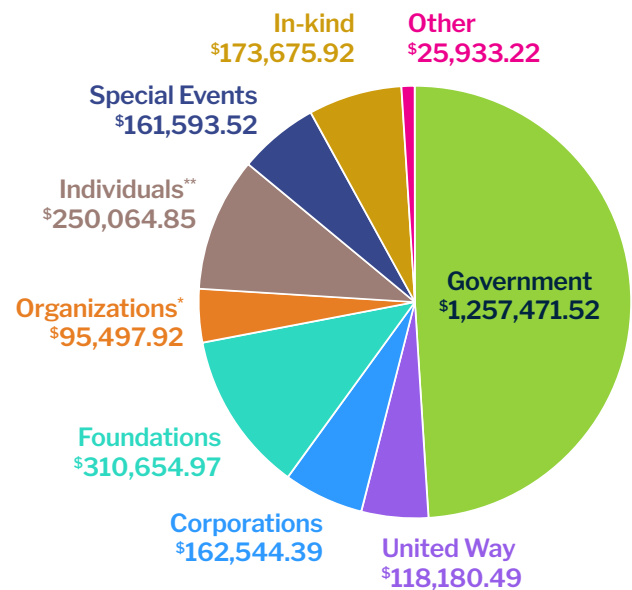

The Boulevard Shelter

Nicholas House’s oldest program – **the Boulevard shelter** – is a safe place to stay when families don’t have any income and need a place to stabilize and gain employment.



98
people had a safe place to sleep last year, with a **4-month** median length of stay.



91%
moved into a permanent home.



66%
acquired a source of income, through either employment or benefit eligibility. **90%** of families served have mainstream benefits.



Homeless to Homes:

Rapid rehousing program for families with some income who need help moving into housing quickly.

121
PEOPLE

were able to move into their own home, with **2.23 months** being the average of how long it took to find housing.

\$1,018
A MONTH

was the average rental and utility assistance provided.

100%
OF FAMILIES

served had the ability to pay their own housing expenses **3 months** after the cessation of housing benefits provided and **100% of families** were still stably housed **12 months** after exit; **94% of families** were still stably housed **24 months** after exit.

Home Again:

Homelessness prevention program for families with some income who need financial assistance to stay in their current home.

New Horizons

Nicholas House's **New Horizons** program provides permanent affordable housing for as long as a family needs it. This program is reserved for families who have chronic health conditions that would make it difficult for them to maintain stable employment. They need stable housing and support so they don't cycle in and out of homelessness.

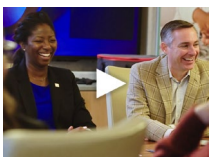
